The applicant declares and acknowledges that:

- Upon a request from CZ.NIC Association sent electronically to the email address provided in the heading of this application at any time during the blocking period, the applicant shall within 14 days provide proof that the proceedings have not yet been concluded; should the applicant fail to do so, the CZ.NIC Association shall be entitled to cancel the blocking without undue delay;

2 For legal entities, a statutory body. In such cases, an original excerpt from the Commercial Register or an excerpt from a similar register must also be submitted with the application (the excerpts must not be older than three months). If the person is acting on behalf of another person, power of attorney must be attached.

- The CZ.NIC Association is also entitled to cancel the blocking if it is duly informed by the corresponding adjudicatory body that the proceedings have been concluded or the dispute has been resolved, or if the domain name holder proves the same;
- In the event that it has been lawfully ruled in the proceedings that the domain name shall be transferred, the CZ.NIC Association shall cancel the blocking upon notification from any of the parties to the dispute and presentation of the original or authenticated copy of the ruling with a clause certifying its legal force, and shall transfer the domain in accordance with such ruling;
- The blocking will be performed for no more than 4 months, and this period cannot be extended;
- The same domain name cannot be blocked again earlier than 12 months following the termination of the previous blocking of the domain name (this does not preclude blocking on the basis of a preliminary injunction);
- The applicant shall be liable for any damage incurred by the domain name holder or the CZ.NIC Association as a result of the blocking;
- The applicant's details, including personal data, shall be processed by the CZ.NIC Association, for the entire period of the registration of the domain name covered by the application and thereafter for 10 years beyond the end of the registration.
